Referat

Alle både kom i løbet af fredagen. Vi havde fået lov til af Havnefogeden at vende alle de grønne skilte på rød ved gæstebroen, og sikke et flot syn det var, alle 11 både ved siden af hinanden og med signalflagene oppe.
